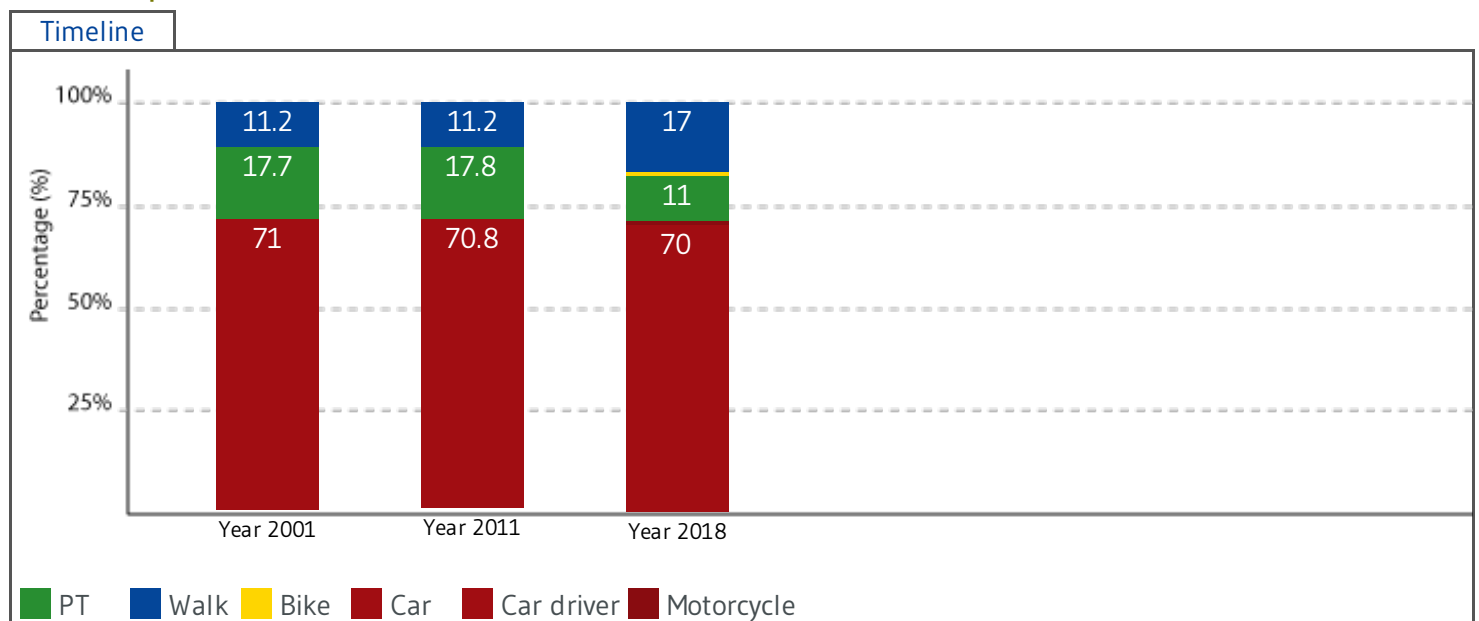

## Status of the Sustainable Urban Mobility Plan

The Municipality of Maia finalized his SUMP/ PMT designated as 'Sustainable Mobility Plan for the Municipality of Maia', in 2013 (available [here](#) ).

In 2014 a Working Group for Mobility and Accessibility, was put in place aiming to coordinate and implement the interventions outlined in the plan.

Still in the area of mobility, but in specific subject areas, the Municipality of Maia has developed the following plans: Municipal Plan Accessibility for All - 2010 (available [here](#) ) and the Municipal Plan for Road Safety (2011).

Under the Portugal 2020 framework, Sustainable Mobility Action Plans are being developed for all the Intermunicipal Communities (NUT III). Maia is integrated in the Metropolitan Area of Porto Action Plan.
