- Showing if our work leads to results and if we are effective.
- Share experiences and have the opportunity to compare results.



SUMO

System for Evaluation of Mobility Projects

- Method for systematic planning, evaluation and control of action.
- Similar evaluations makes it easier to:
 - Exchanging experiences
 - Compare
 - Describe effect relationships

Background SUMO

- In 2004 the Swedish Road Administration launched SUMO.
- Marketing of SUMO.
- Training in SUMO.
- Demand for readymade patterns for mobility measures.



SARA database

Results of Activities of Sector Players

- Based on SUMO.
- Gives the user support in both planning and follow-up.
- Includes patterns of measures for 10 mobility and road safety measures.
- SARA was launched in December 2008
