With this e-update, we are happy to re-announce the next edition of our annual award for the **most effective international transfer of policy or best practise on Mobility Management**. Likely candidates will come from ongoing or completed EU-projects from the Interreg, Intelligent Energy Europe and DG MOVE projects that have achieved a transfer in international policy from one entity to another as a result of the approaches they have used. Also bilateral transfer examples are welcome.

An international Jury will decide on the winner and runners-up begin March. The winners will receive a free ticket to the ECOMM (value approx. 500€) - and travel costs will be reimbursed.
